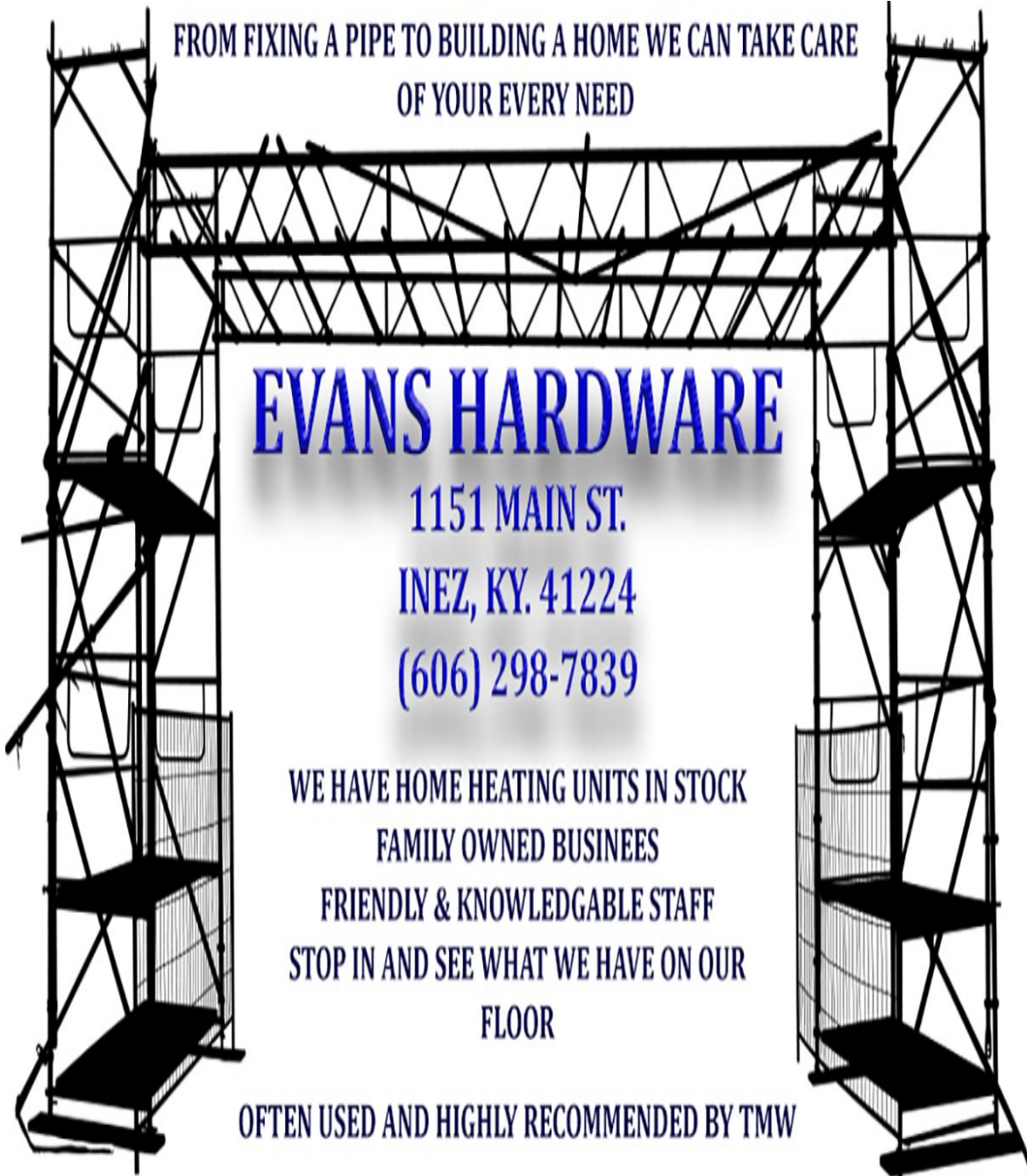

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MARTIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT RELATING TO THE  
RIGHT-OF-WAYS AND THE PROCEDURES FOR STREET NAME APPROVAL AND  
STREET ADDRESS ASSIGNMENT

Upon motion, the Martin County Fiscal Court hereby orders that the following 911 Ordinance be approved.

WHEREAS, a 911 Emergency Telephone Service has been established for the unincorporated areas of Martin County, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, to provide for public safety and to implement an Enhanced 911 Emergency Telephone Service, it will be necessary that all properties and the principal buildings or structures situated thereon be identified and assigned an address.

WHEREAS, Martin County Fiscal Court is currently in the process of readdressing all properties within the incorporated areas of Martin County, Kentucky, and shall issue address identification numbers for all principal buildings, structures, and structures with multiple units or mobile homes thereon;

**SECTION 1. DISPLAY OF ADDRESS IDENTIFICATION NUMBER**

The owner or occupant or person in charge of any house, building, mobile home or other structure within the area served by the 911 Emergency Telephone Service and for which an address identification number is assigned by the 911 Coordinator shall within thirty (30) days following receipt of the complete Address Notification Form:

(a) cause the numbers assigned to said building, mobile home, structure or unit within a multi-unit structure to be permanently and prominently displayed at a size of not less than four inches (4") in height in a conspicuous place upon said building, mobile home, structure or unit of a multi-unit structure so as to be clearly visible and identifiable at all times during daylight hours; if the structure is not visible from the main road or is more than fifty (50) feet from the main road, the assigned 911 number shall be placed at the end of the driveway.

(b) further cause any mailbox serving said building, mobile home, structure or unit within a multi-unit structure to permanently and prominently display the assigned number at a size of not less than four inches (4") in height;

(c) cause the numbers assigned to be permanently and prominently displayed at a size of not less than four inches (4") in height on a number post clearly visible and identifiable from the road or the street designated on the Address Notification Form if neither the address identification number displayed upon the structure nor the address identification number displayed upon the mailbox are discernable from the street or road on which the structure is located;

(d) cause the removal or obliteration from the structure and/or mailbox of any numbers different from that designated in the Address Notification Form.

**SECTION 2. NEW STRUCTURES AND MOBILE HOMES**

All persons, firms, corporations and other legal entities constructing new structures or locating or relocating mobile homes in Martin County, Kentucky, from and after this date shall apply for and obtain from the 911 Coordinator an address identification. Upon such request, the 911 Coordinator shall assign to said structure or mobile home an address identification which shall be furnished to the applicant by the 911 Coordinator to present to the United States Post Office.

The 911 Coordinator shall maintain a record of all numbers and addresses assigned.

**SECTION 3. RENUMBERING OF ADDRESSES**

Whenever it shall become necessary and advisable to renumber any or all buildings, mobile homes, structures or units of multi-unit structures on a street or road, the 911 Coordinator shall make a list of all renumbered properties and notify the owners or occupants thereof of the renumbered address for display upon said properties as herein provided.

**SECTION 4. PENALTIES**

Any person who knowingly and willfully violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00). Each day on which the violation occurs may constitute a separate offense.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication and recording, according to law.
